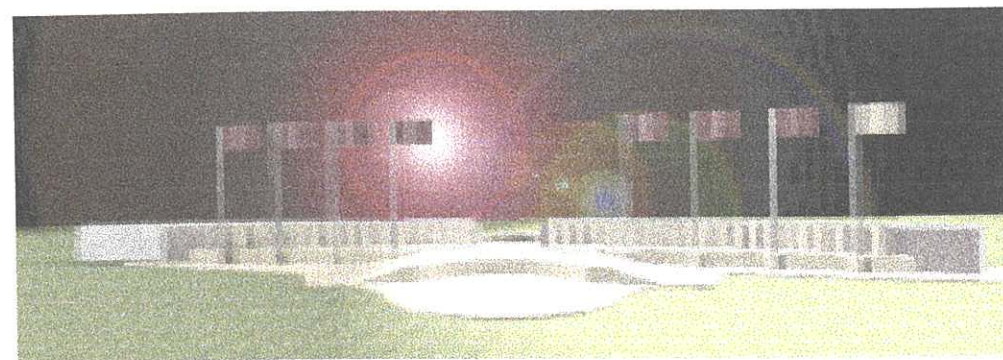
Concept

The idea behind this proposal is to return Padang Kota to the people of Penang and tourists alike. Penang has a dearth of public places, and even though Padang Kota is popular, the field itself is rarely utilized by the public. Creating a public monument in which the people can use is the main aim and raison d'être behind this proposal. We have chosen to design a 'monument' which is not an actual edifice but a landscape option, reflective of the natural environment of the island.

Proposal

The proposal itself is a landscaped proposal where the time capsule is placed underneath a fountain. The fountain was designed in order to allow families to bring their children to view, touch, and experience the Millennium monument. One can approach the monument from all sides; the road, the field or the pavement. The monument is proposed to be off form concrete on one side, with all the significant events listed and carved into the wall. Significant events to be included can be the time Sir Francis Light made Penang into a significant trading post, World War II, when Penang lost its free port status, when Penang started the Free Trade Zone, when

KOMTAR was built, etc. All the significant events, the people who shaped them and so forth can be carved and recorded on the concrete wall. On the other side of the wall is a wall of aluminium panels. Significant events of the new century as they occur can be recorded on the panels. These panels are demountable and removable for the recording year by year. As such, this monument will change and progress with time.

A stage for events is still allowed for. Flag posts have also been placed in order that tensile structure can be erected in the event of rain.

Location

The location of the monument has been sited where there is a present stage. As the stage is not designed and is only used on rare occasions, this provides a place for intervention without causing any conflict with the surrounding environment.

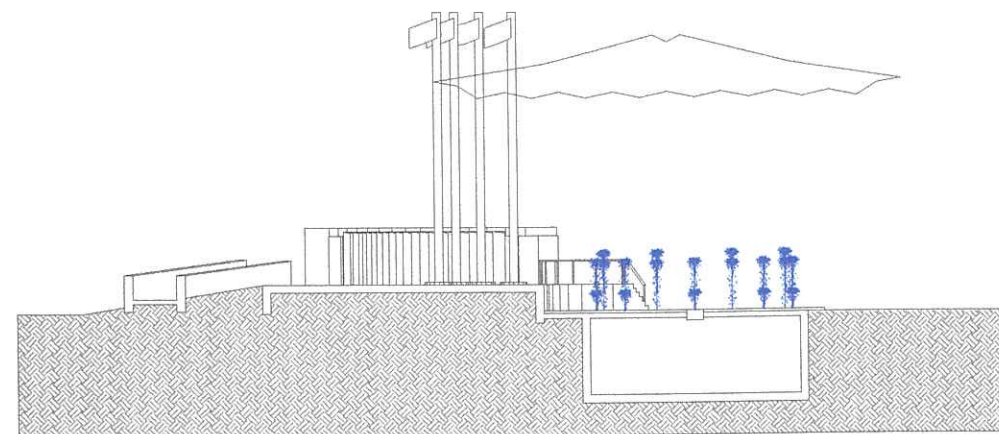

10. Kota Cornwallis (Fort Cornwallis)



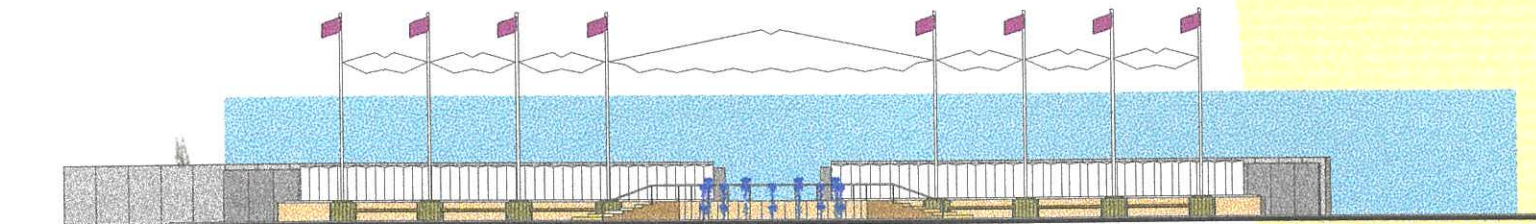
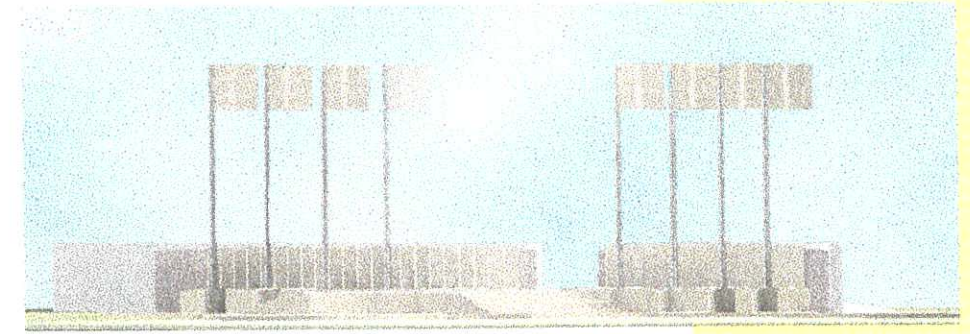

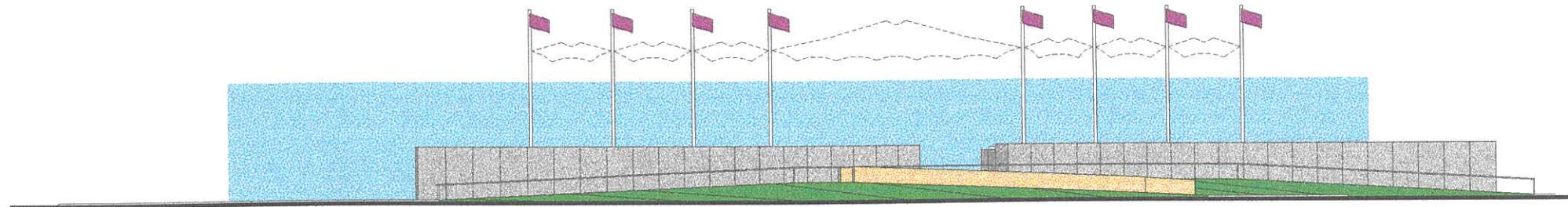
Example of Water Fountain

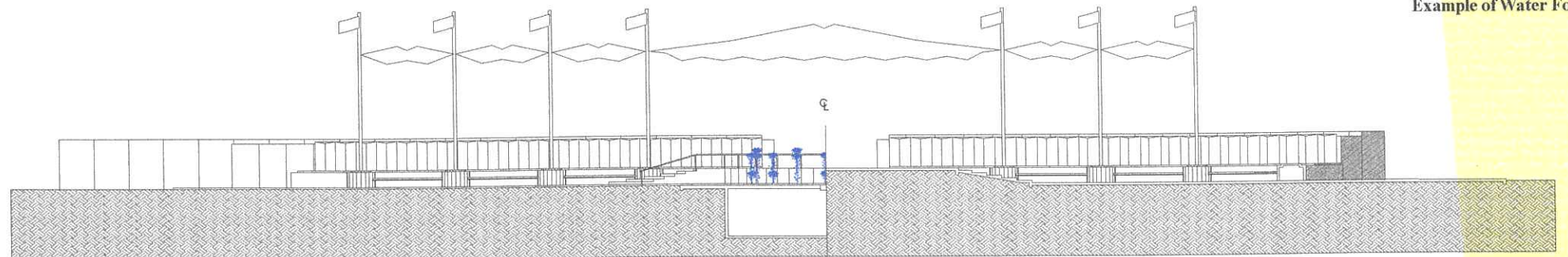
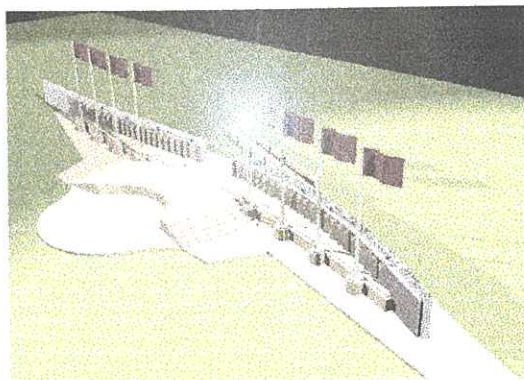
Elevation From Field
